- ▶ Support in evaluating your housing options and strategies to increase these opportunities
- ▶ A review of your confidentiality and privacy rights
- ▶ You may be asked to complete the VI-SPDAT assessment

What is the VI-SPDAT?

Implemented by the Coordinated Entry System (CES), the **Vulnerability Index-Service Prioritization Decision Assistance Tool** enables providers to fairly and uniformly provide resources to those in need based on:

1. Level of need
2. Appropriate Housing Intervention
3. Available housing resources within CES

The **Coordinated Entry System** (CES) is not an emergency solution.

Completing an VI-SPDAT assessment is not a guarantee of housing.



MORE INFORMATION

What Happens After the Assessment?

- ▶ It is important to continue to attempt to access all other opportunities for housing to include roommate location services, rooms for rent, family, friends, other natural supports, and other community resources.
- ▶ Update any changes to your contact information so that someone can contact you regarding potential housing resources. This can be done at most assessment sites.
- ▶ Start collecting your necessary documentation (CA ID, SS card, birth certificate, & DD214 if applicable). Documents can be scanned into your record at most assessment sites.
- ▶ After completing a VI-SPDAT, you may be assigned to a Housing Navigator, based on need, scores, priorities, and staff caseload.
