

Brandon Keiser's Homicide Remains Unsolved

\$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the Oceanside Police Department's Crimes of Violence Unit are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the suspect(s) responsible for the murder of Brandon Keiser.

On March 22, 2016 at approximately 10:05 p.m., police officers from the Oceanside Police Department responded to a report of a shooting in the 400 block of S. Freeman Street. Officers found the victim, identified as 35-year-old Oceanside resident Brandon Keiser, lying on the sidewalk in front of 410 S. Freeman Street. Brandon Keiser was suffering from at least one gunshot wound and was pronounced deceased at the scene. Witnesses reported hearing an argument followed by multiple gunshots.

Brandon Keiser had a passion for surfing, helping others, and was loved by many.
